



Product Development Engineer

The role & department

The Product Development department is responsible to keep the Modification Business Line competitive. This is done by providing new insights into the market and developing new Product Market Combinations (PMCs) or improving existing PMCs accordingly. The Product Development Engineer plays a crucial role in this process.

In this position, you are responsible for the definition and development of new concept designs from which the most feasible ones will be further developed and added to the product portfolio of Fokker Services.

Your key responsibilities

The Product Development Engineer is engaged with the development of new concepts, recognizing opportunities, and monitoring (future) airworthiness and operational requirements.

In this position, your main responsibilities and duties are:

- Responsible to provide concept development studies (incl. potential solutions, technical feasibility, certification requirements, cost estimate, milestone planning and future developments), which will be an essential part of the business cases for new products;
- Continuous monitoring of (upcoming) airworthiness and operational requirements, he/she is the person to go to w.r.t. (upcoming) requirements;
- Support to the product Manager to explore the market for new opportunities;
- Regular consultation with stakeholders such as authorities, suppliers, customers (via meetings, on site visit, trade shows etc.)
- Prepare and execute "Concept Design Reviews" for the products that you have developed;
- Create awareness and gain acceptance for the new concepts within own organization.

What do we ask from you?

The Product Development Engineer must have thorough technical knowledge of aircraft systems and design (preferably in the field of interior and In Flight Connectivity related upgrades), sharp analytical and strong communication skills. Furthermore, the Product Development Engineer must be able to multitask as you will work on many different projects simultaneously. Next to the analytical skills you should also be able to maintain a helicopter view to distinguish between detail and high over concepts.

Furthermore you:

- Have a Master or Bachelor degree, preferably in Aviation;
- have an open mind, thinking in possibilities;
- are enthusiastic and a team player;
- have thorough technical knowledge in your field of expertise;
- have strong communication skills;
- have the ability to multitask and work on several projects simultaneously;
- preferably have experience in project management;
- are customer oriented, able to present technical knowledge to people who are less familiar with the field and to show the necessity of the product.
