As the Type Certificate Holder of the Fokker aircraft types, we are responsible for maintaining the Operational documents of the Fokker aircraft types.

As intern you will be assigned to work on 2 operational manuals: Aircraft Operation Manual (AOM) and Quick Reference Handbook (QRH).

Your job is to review the emergency and abnormal procedures of the Fokker 70 and Fokker 100 types with the goal to harmonize and combine the text and publish these procedures in the QRH only.

This is a hands-on assignment and you work under the supervision of a Technical Author and a Design Engineer of Fokker Services.

Location

The location of the internship is Fokker Services, location Hoeksteen 40, Hoofddorp.

Profile

The expected level of the trainee is preferably HBO with a technical course (e.g. Aviation Engineering or Flight, Aeronautical Engineering). Be able to connect with several people to understand the current process.
