The internship assignment – CASA contract standardization

As the Type Certificate Holder of the Fokker aircraft types, we offer customers a Continued Airworthiness Support Agreement (named: CASA 2.0). The prime intention of this program is to maintain the TCH obligations and to provide products and services that are relevant to the operators/owners of Fokker aircraft to ensure continued airworthiness and economic operation of their fleet.

Operators/owners of Fokker aircraft can request CASA membership at Fokker Services and after accepting the proposal a suite of products, including 7x24 support is offered. As an intern you will be assigned to investigate how we can improve the CASA membership process by standardizing the various process steps and to offer the standard products via the MyFokkerFleet website.

Our aim is to enable operators/owners to select their requested products and to generate a proposal by one click on the mentioned website. You will investigate the possible improvements and draw up a priority list and implementation timeline, in close cooperation with our CASA Product Manager and Sales and Marketing teams.
